Welcome to Esch-sur-Alzette, European Capital of Culture 2022!

From 25 to 28 May 2022, the European Capital of Culture, its partner municipalities and a number of municipalities in the country will be focusing on music education with a festive and varied programme for pupils, teachers and leaders of music schools and conservatories from many European countries.

The programme will start with the 47th General Assembly of the European Music School Union (EMU) and the 14th European Music School Forum, focused on the theme of 'Music school teachers in the future - a profile under change'. I would like to extend a warm welcome to all EMU delegates in Esch-sur-Alzette, and especially to the EMU presidium, headed by President Philippe Dalarun (France) and Vice-President Romain Asselborn (Luxembourg). Mr Asselborn is also President of the Association des

écoles de musique du Grand-Duché de Luxembourg, the Luxembourg member association of the EMU.

In 2022, the entry into force on 1 September 2022 of the new law on the organisation of music education in the municipal sector marks an important and innovative year for music education in Luxembourg.

Luxembourg will be the first country to introduce free public music education for all children and young people. From the start of the 2022-2023 school year, a large proportion of lessons will be free for pupils aged between 4 and 18. The new law is an important step in Luxembourg's education policy, which seeks to offer all children and young people the best opportunities for the future.

Free quality music education makes training accessible to all

children and young people that contributes to their individual development and supports improvement in their skill levels. Investment in music education not only strengthens our cultural traditions and social cohesion, but also passes on important future skills to future generations.

Free tuition is available for group and individual lessons in music, speech arts and dance, starting with the three-year early musical, instrumental and dance training, followed by general ear training, instrumental training, vocal training, dance training as well as theatre and speech arts training up to the first cycle diploma (a total of seven years of study).

About two thirds of the lessons currently offered in Luxembourg will be provided free of charge and about two thirds of all students enrolled in local music schools, regional music schools and conservatories will benefit from free tuition.

A highlight of the 14th European Youth Music Festival will undoubtedly be the opening concert of the festival, featuring the Orchestre de Chambre du Luxembourg and a large number of students from Luxembourg's music schools,

who will perform alongside the orchestra's musicians. The many student ensembles from various music schools from all over Europe will also offer concerts throughout the country.

I would like to thank the organisers of this important European meeting in Luxembourg and I would like to wish all of you, students, teachers, music school leaders and EMU delegates, an emotion-filled stay, full of beautiful musical moments and unforgettable memories.

On behalf of the Luxembourgish Association of Music Schools, it is my great honour and pleasure to welcome you to the 47th European Music School Union (EMU) General Assembly here in Luxembourg. We are very proud that we, as a small country with an equally small music school association, can organise this assembly. It gives us the unique opportunity to show you, our European guests and colleagues, the music education scene we cultivate and promote here in Luxembourg.

In Luxembourg, music education is an important part of childhood education. The musical schools that provide this education are highly supported by the Government and the municipalities. The best proof of this is the reform of the music school system, which will come into force on 1 September 2022. From that date, every child up to age 18 must have free access to music, theatre, and dance lessons in all Luxembourgish municipal music schools. Free and accessible

music education is a unique pioneering decision in Europe and I am convinced that in the years to come it will become clear that it was the right move.

Furthermore, the University of Luxembourg offers since September 2021 a new Bachelor's degree in Music Education to students wishing to follow a university course to become a music teacher. The University will provide training in musicology and music pedagogy, while the conservatories and music schools are entrusted with musical and instrumental training. The programme will be presented in the European Music School Forum "Music School Teachers in the Future - A profile under change".

I look very forward to this 14th EMU European Youth Music School Festival for which the title "Remix22" has been chosen. The conditions for organising this festival could not have been more challenging. The Covid-19 pandemic was followed by the Russian invasion of Ukraine.

With the will to set a sign for freedom in Europe, we followed our goal, and are very happy and grateful that we can all be together today. This very event shows that music can bring us, Europeans, closer together.

A warm thank you to the event organisers and all those involved in making this festival possible. I would also like to thank our partners and sponsors that you all find mentioned in this booklet. Finally, I thank all political representatives at national and local level for their support. I'd like to give special thanks to Bob Morhard, the general manager of the "Remix22" festival, for his tireless commitment and tremendous work organising the festival. 



About the European Music School Union (EMU)

The European Music School Union (EMU) is the European umbrella organization of national music school associations in Europe. The EMU is a non-governmental and a non-profit organization. The EMU represents a supranational platform comprised of member associations from various countries. These countries need not be members of the European Union (EU).

At present, national music school associations from 26 European countries are members of the EMU. Thus, the EMU represents more than:

6.000 Music schools

150.000 Teaching staff

4.000.000 Pupils/students

1.500.000.000 euro turnover

The EMU has achieved the status of councilor within the European Council (EC). The EMU is a member of the European Music Council (EMC) and the International Music Council (IMC).

EMU's organization comprises the General Assembly, the Presidium and the General Secretariat, which is presently situated in Berlin (Germany).

National member associations of the EMU are officially acknowledged to work for the public interest and, as a rule, they receive public funding. Their task is to secure nation-wide standards and to develop infrastructures for the work of their member music schools, such as:

curricular development, organizational assistance and further trainings. Some countries have laid down legislation related to music schools. Guidelines for membership to the EMU are set out in the EMU's Statutes.

Music Schools in Europe are institutions especially devoted to musical education and chiefly geared towards the practical aspects of music-making. Although the term "music school" is common in nearly all European countries, there are no binding international requirements that a music school has to fulfil.

Membership of one of the national music school associations affiliated to the EMU, however, entails certain conditions, such as public responsibility and public funding, quality standards in structure and curricula, a wide range of subjects, qualification of teaching staff, public performances and so on.

Music schools are generally attended by children and youngsters but, as a rule, are also open to adults up to senior age. Music schools enable people to participate in music making on every level up to preparation for professional music studies.

A "music school" in Europe is a clearly defined institution, which forms an integral part of the European educational system. Many music schools co-operate closely with regular schools.
