During the year 2022The Association of Music and Ballet Schools of Serbia performed following activities:

NATIONAL COMPETITION AND FESTIVAL OF MUSIC AND BALLET SCHOOLS OF SERBIA

The Association has successfully organized and realized **National Competition** f rom 1-15 April 2022 in Belgarde and Novi Sad, gathering more than 1000 participants in the following disciplines: wood and brass instruments, piano, clasical sollo singing, ethnic singing and ethno instruments. Competitors were juged by national jury and the level of the competition was on exceptionally high. The competition was organized live.

Festival of Music Schools was held from 7th to 13th May in Niš. 54 schools from Serbia took part in the Festival, wich is organized very professionaly and in the best possible way. The Festival was organized live.

COOPERATION WITH EMU

Cooperation of our country with EMU is, therefore, more powerful and effective. Delegate for the Assembly is Slađana Šegavčić, the president of The Association of Music and Ballet Schools of Serbia. As representatives of Serbia, they took part in the General Assembly, held in Luxembourg, from 25 to 28 May.Serbian delegate Aleksandar Đurić is one of the members of the EMU Presidency.

PROFESSIONAL TRAINING

The Association was very operational when it comes to the organization of professional trainings and seminars. During October and November, series of acrcredited seminars were organized in Krupanj, for 60 professors and principals of music and ballet schools.

PRESIDENCY

The Association Presidency held 8 meetings (online and live, depending on the situation) during the year 2022, where it was considered the organisation and realisation of planned activities, collaboration between different regions of Serbia and collaboration with other regional associations. The Presidency coordinated the work on cooperation with the Ministry of Education, Science and Technological Development, local authorities from all regions in Serbia.

ASSEMBLY AND ELEKTORAL ASSEMBLY OF THE ASSOCIATION OF MUSIC AND BALLET SCHOOLS OF SERBIA ZMBŠS

In 2022, general assemblies were organized twice, in March and in November

All the activities were successfully realized, according to the plan for the year 2021. Preparations and organization of the electoral assembly was held in November.

New Presidium and members of the Supervisory Board was elected.

INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

The association has a long-term cooperation with ESYO (European Spirit of Youth Orchestra), under the direction of Igor Coreti. Students from Serbian music schools participate in summer and winter orchestra tours and play in concerts organized during the tours.
