PROGRAMME

The General Assembly and Forum will take place at the Auditorium of Vic. The GA will be held in English language with simultaneous translations into French and German.

Delegates are invited to come to Vic on May 28 to attend the opening and welcome dinner in the evening. The GA will be held on Thursday, 29 May in the morning from 9.30 to 13.00. The first part of the European Music School Forum will start in the afternoon of the same day followed by the opening ceremony of the RITMIKS, the XV. European Youth Music Festival, in the evening. The forum will be resumed on Friday morning and delegates will have the chance to visit the various festival venues in the afternoon. Saturday will be fully dedicated to the festival and delegates are invited to return home on Sunday 1 June.

ACCOMMODATION

The ACEM covers the accommodation and subsistence cost for the honorary members and for one delegate from each member country during the General Assembly and European Music School Forum for a maximum of 4 nights. We hope to see as many participants as possible from our member associations, but please note that extra participants will have to cover their own accommodation and subsistence costs. All delegates and participants will be accommodated at the Hotel Pamplona and Hotel Balmes in Vic.

TRANSPORT FROM BARCELONA-EL PRAT AIRPORT TO VIC

Shuttle buses from the airport to Vic will run **on Wednesday, May 28** at 10:00, 12:00, 14:00, and 16:00. Return buses will be available on: **Friday, May 30**, at 13:30 and 16:00 (last day of the forum) or on **Sunday, June 1**, at 9:00 and 11:00 (after the festival ends). In the coming weeks, the ACEM will ask for your flight details, arrival time, and you will be able to choose the shuttle schedule that suits you best.
