

Public transport from Barcelona to Vic

Step 1: Find the Bus Stop

The bus to Vic is operated by Sagalés - line e12. The bus stop is centrally located in Barcelona, easily accessible from major areas like Plaça Catalunya or Passeig de Gràcia.



The exact location is <u>Gran Via de les Corts Catalanes 656 - Roger de Llúria</u>, near the corner of Gran Via and Roger de Llúria streets. Look for blue bus stop signs displaying the route number (e12) and its destination.

Step 2: Board the e12 Bus

The bus is clearly marked as e12, with the final destination shown as Vic Bus Station (Estació d'Autobusos de Vic). The journey to Vic takes approximately 1 hour and 12 minutes, with 2 stops along the way. Before boarding, confirm with the driver or check the display inside the bus to ensure it is headed to Vic. Keep your ticket accessible, as inspectors may check it during the trip.

Step 3: Arrive at Vic Bus Station

Get off at Vic Bus Station (Parada 2290).

Step 4: Walk to Atlàntida Performing Arts Center

From Vic Bus Station, it's a 17-minute walk (approximately 1.3 kilometers) to the <u>Atlantida Performing Arts Center</u>. Follow Carrer de Francesc Maria Masferrer to reach your destination.

When booking, select: Origin: Barcelona (Sagrera)

Destination: Vic

Purchasing Tickets Onboard: Tickets can also be purchased directly from the driver. Payment must be in cash, with bills no larger than €20. The cost is €9.45.
